

We are in our eleventh year of the Faith in our Family "Adopt a Student" Scholarship program. Over the previous ten years, parishioners have donated over \$340,000 to fund the scholarships, and Catholic Education has been made more affordable for many, many families. If you would like to donate this year, please complete a pledge card available at the back of church, and return it to the parish office.

We have just received our Third ADA report from the Diocese, and we still have a lot of work to do.

Our Goal is \$94,134. To date, 183 families have pledged \$71,688 with a total received of \$55,229. We have a long way to go! If you have not sent in your pledge card please consider doing it soon. Additional pledge cards are in the back of the church or in the parish office.

### *Did you Know?* Your child <u>can</u> attend a Catholic School Financial Assistance Is Available

Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2023 -2024 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website <u>www.cdop.org</u> under *Catholic Education* and then under *Financial Assistance*. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: <u>online.factsmgt.com/aid</u>. Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2023-2024 school year must reapply.


Deadline date for the completed application is April 28, 2023. Notification of grant awards will be made in June of 2023.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at <u>www.empowerillinois.org</u>. Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.


